Lake Shore Temperature Sensor RoHS – Current Status

Lake Shore's Temperature Sensors are currently covered under [exemption 26](#) of the RoHS Directive Annex IV. The current exemption expired on June 30, 2021, however, Lake Shore applied for a renewal which is being reviewed by the Commission. You can see the status of the [Exemptions here](#) (See Excel download, currently line 329).

Until a decision is made by the commission, the existing Exemption is valid (see [RoHS Directive Exemptions Procedure](#)). The latest report from the European Commission recommending a renewal through June 30, 2028, can be found here ([Study to assess requests for renewal of 16 exemptions to Annex IV of Directive 2011/65/EU - Publications Office of the EU \(europa.eu\)](#)). Our exemption is covered in section 15 starting on page 341.
